Each home creates an environment that aids in the physical, mental, and spiritual development of residents.

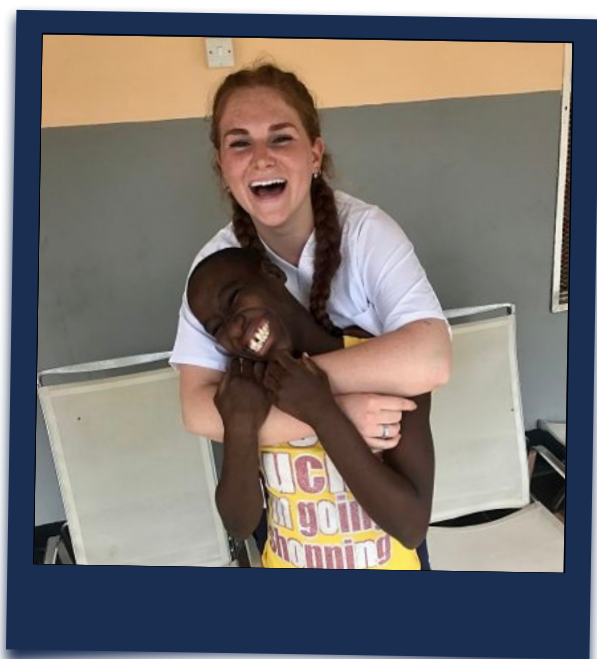
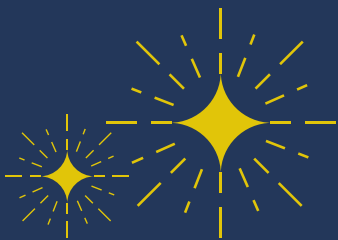
