

Big Picture

- 64% of total responses "agree" or "strongly agree" to statements
- 15% of total responses "disagree" or "strongly disagree" statements
- 30% neutral

70+% of respondents responded positively:

- relationship with Jesus
- communicating important information in a timely manner
- receiving messages in variety of ways
- student safety
- prayer life outside of classrooms
- extracurriculars outside of the classroom
- hearing of student successes

Almost 50% of respondents responded negatively:

- understanding how decisions/policies are made
- having a strong sense of what the school will be like in 3, 5, 10 years

Comments:

- concerned over consistency of disciplinary process (10%)
- interest in library and technology classes (7%)

Stewardship Model

- Income divided by expenses equals Cost to Educate
- All students receive scholarship up to a certain amount
- Families who can afford more choose to pay increased prices, potentially up to the Cost to Educate
- The saved scholarship money assists families who cannot afford to pay at the Cost to Educate or base scholarship amount


